Nourishing families who serve

Sentara has supported the Armed Services YMCA of Hampton Roads for the past two years with grants to their Patriot's Pantry Food Distribution Program. The Patriot's Pantry serves active-duty service members and their families across the Southside, Peninsula and Western Tidewater. Most recipients are junior-enlisted families who often fall into low-to-moderate-income brackets. The grant money is used to purchase food for the main pantry in Virginia Beach, stock their mobile pantry deliveries and fund Operation Holiday Joy, which provides full Thanksgiving meals. "We are so grateful for Sentara's support," says Debbie Brinkley, grants manager. "Their investment has had a huge impact."
